CEO of Cucamonga Valley Water District Robert DeLoach to address business group

Mr. DeLoach is currently the General Manager and Chief Executive Officer for the Cucamonga Valley Water District, a public agency located in Rancho Cucamonga, California. Cucamonga Valley Water District provides water and sewer services to an area covering 52 square miles, which presently serves the City of Rancho Cucamonga and portions of Fontana, Upland, Ontario, and San Bernardino County. He is also the President of Fontana Union Water Company, a mutual water company with extensive water rights in the Lytle Creek region.

Mr. DeLoach received his Bachelor of Arts degree in Administration from California State University in Pomona. He also studied Civil Engineering at Imperial Valley College.

Prior to his affiliation with Cucamonga Valley Water, he was the Director of Public Works and Engineering for the Cities of Pomona and Azusa. Before starting his work in the public sector, he was a California State licensed contractor.

- For the past ten years, Mr. DeLoach has been involved in the management activities within the Chino Groundwater Basin, one of the largest groundwater acquisitions in southern California.
- Mr. DeLoach was appointed to the Association of California Water Agencies (ACWA) Legislative Committee in 2003.

Mr. DeLoach has served in a variety of professional capabilities, such as the past chair of the Chino Basin Advisory Committee; past member of the California Chapter of the American Public Works Association; past president of Canon Water Company; past president of East San Gabriel Valley Engineers Association; and Administrator for the Pomona-Rowland-Walnut Joint Waterline Commission. Mr. DeLoach is a member of the Rancho Cucamonga Rotary Club.
