

Ray Moors Candidate for 61st Assembly District Will Address the Inland Valley Business Alliance Monday, August 9th

RANCHO CUCAMONGA, CA Aug.4 Chino resident, Ray Moors, candidate for the 61st Assembly District, will present his message to the Inland Valley Business Alliance on his plans to protect California businesses from money hungry bureaucrats Monday, August 9th at Antonino's Ristorante Italiano at 11:30 a.m.

Mr. Moors, a Republican, is running against Democrat incumbent Norma Torres. He is owner of Joey's Bar-B-Q restaurants in the Inland Empire.
